The Career Center Faculty & Staff Career Innovation Grant (FSCIG) provides funding for UD faculty and staff to create professional and career development activities for their students. Funding is provided to offset costs associated with infusing career-related materials and/or experiences into existing or new class curricula and/or departmental program, or school-based initiatives.

► **APPLICATIONS ACCEPTED: JULY 1, 2019 - APRIL 30, 2020** ◀

Grants will be awarded up to a maximum of \$2,500 per semester, but applications will be reviewed equally regardless of the amount of requested funding.

General Career Services Grant:

Can be used for hosting networking events, bringing industry leaders to campus, etc.

Career Trek Grant:

Can be used for taking students to employer sites, transportation to conferences (small and large groups), etc.
